

Graffiti report breakdown as of December 21, 2007

BACKGROUND & SUMMARY:

The Number of graffiti complaints fluctuates depending on the following variables:

- Temperature – Cold temperature reduces activity, Incidents drop during rain & snow storms
- Season – When Students are on vacation/ holiday/ in-service graffiti increases
- Response Priority (1)City Properties (2)Private Properties (3)Commercial Properties
- Response times may vary depending on graffiti incidents and weather. Can't paint or power wash when weather is below 35 degrees.*Note Calls logged on Friday afternoon will be addressed the following Monday
- Staff hours 7:00am to 4:00 pm Monday thru Friday
